I must say---and I've heard this from many others---it was wonderful to see a full church of dear souls here to celebrate Our Blessed Lord's rising from the dead and his victory from the Glorious Cross: we must pray that we never again have another "virtual" Holy Week and Easter, but forever and always a **real** one, like the one just passed; and we must pray for all those followers of Christ whose desires and longings to celebrate the Death and Resurrection of Christ were stymied and frustrated by a smotheringly evil oppression which manipulates fear so as to engage in a totalitarian-style form of social control that tyrants from ancient times till now would be wickedly proud of.
