Picnic drive-thru

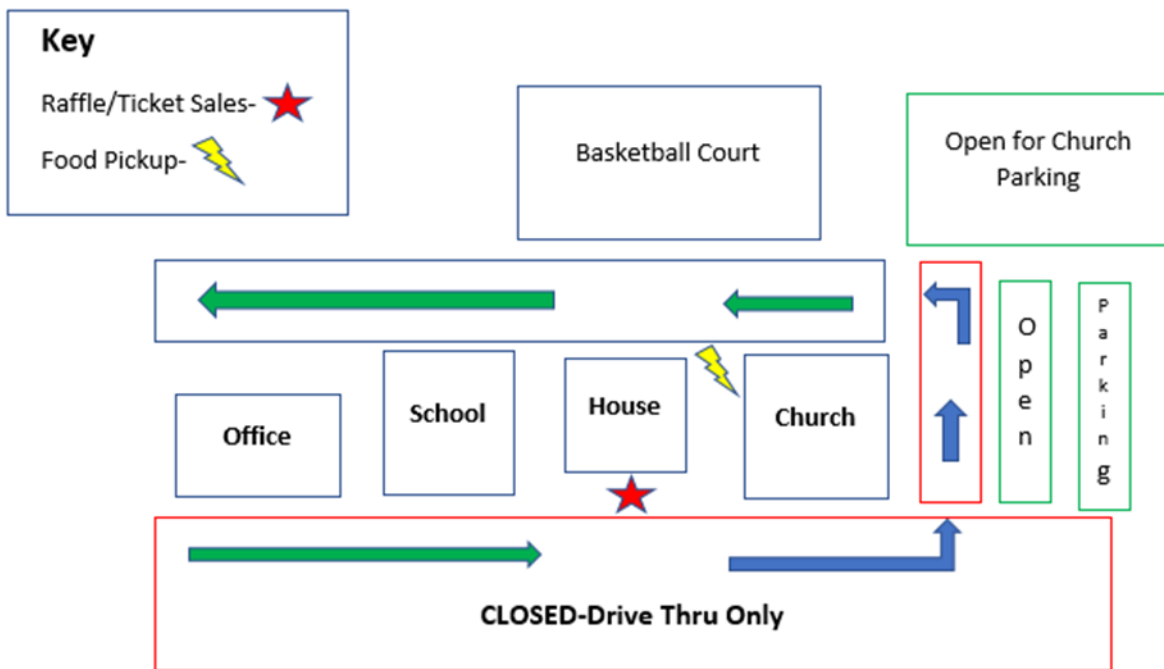
