Dear Parishioners:

I write this from Ohio, visiting my sisters and then going up to NE Ohio to see my brother and his family for a few days. None of my kith and kin have gotten this virus as of this time, and several of them work in medicine. I always pray for the sick, and am doing so now in a special way for those in our parish family who are afflicted at the moment: pray the Lord that both the virus and the effects of the response to it in both our society, nation, and church pass as quickly as possible. I will be offering Mass today (8/5 Our Lady of the Snows) for any and all currently ill with this malady.

This is just a simple reminder that our property insurance has---as it does this time every year---come due; and here are the numbers: **Clear Creek \$3,996.....Clifton City \$1,277.....Pilot Grove \$17,566-----Clear Creek and Clifton went up a bit and Pilot Grove went down a bit.....GRAND TOTAL: \$22,839.**

Ordinarily, the profits from the annual picnic go to cover the cost of the property insurance: given the current state of affairs with the covid-19 situation, the picnic is going to be, understandably, a bit scaled down, so two things are really important and essential:
