All School Picture

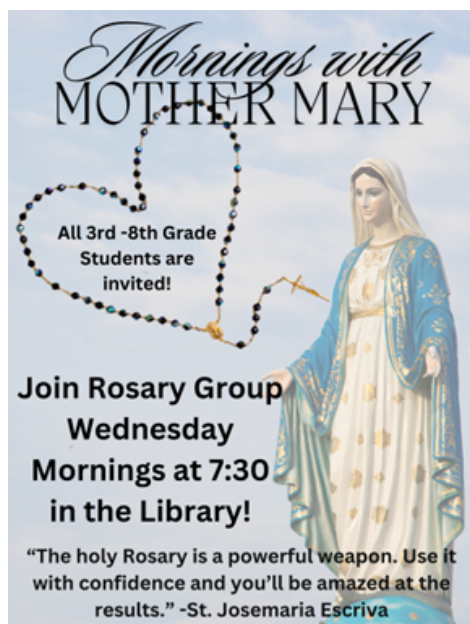
The all-school picture will be on Wednesday, April 1st. Order forms are included in folders this week. Please return order forms by Wednesday.
