Food and Coat Drive

The student council will be hosting a food and coat drive going on now until November 22nd. The food drive will benefit the Food Bank of Central and Northeast Missouri. The coat drive will benefit the Harvest House in Boonville. Monetary donations will also be accepted for both the Food Bank and the Harvest House. For every dollar given to the Food Bank they are able to provide \$21 in food. Items in high demand are; canned meat, vegetables, and fruit, box meals, cereal, peanut butter, bagged/boxed rice, beans, and pasta, and soups. The Student Council will deliver all items when they volunteer at the Food Bank. We challenged the students to each bring in \$1 to donate, even if it was in change! That would translate into \$1,512 worth of food for the food bank!!

Drop Off/Pick Up

In the self study that took place 7 years ago one concern that came up were the pick up/drop off procedures that were taking place at the time. After that self study the new procedures were put into place. Those procedures include that all students should be dropped off behind school in the morning and parents should pull behind school to pick students up at the end of the day.
