## Catholic Schools Week

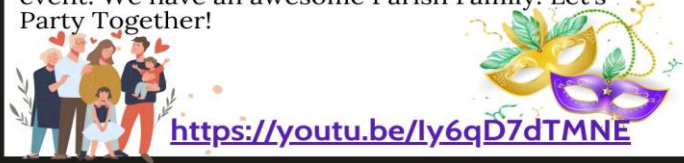
