#### Addressing the Future

With the growing population of our student body the need for additional space has also been a growing concern. Alongside a long-term planning committee, the school advisory board has been working on plans to gain additional classroom space. It is our goal to maintain the low teacher to student ratio St. Joseph has always flourished under. According to the Show Me Institute the average class size in Missouri is 11.3 students per teacher. Our current student to teacher ratio is 13.1 and in the upcoming years some of our lower grade levels will exceed 27 students per double graded classroom. Not only will this present a challenge for physical space, but it will also affect the ability of the classroom teacher to provide individualized instruction. The next steps coming forward in the months ahead will be sharing more information at Mass and holding informational meetings. These will be open to all parishioners and parents, and we ask anyone with any ideas, suggestions, or that would like to be involved to contact a committee member listed below. As we go through the process of exploring the best options for our school and parish, we ask that you pray for those charged with coming up with solutions for our greatest blessings, the current and future St. Joseph's Cougars and God's little disciples.
