In October we begin the faithful process of transitioning our parish to the Catholic Stewardship Renewal model. As we begin this transition, there will be many changes including our current way of fundraising for the parish and our school. Part of these changes include the implementation of a tithe to the diocese on money raised at our fundraisers. We are, however, allowed to have two "tithe free" fundraisers each year, one for the church and one for the school. These two events are exempt from the 10% tithe to the diocese, and the money raised must be spent in our parish on major repairs, or capital improvement projects. This year's tithe free event for the school is our upcoming Home & School Auction. The improvements we hope to support with this year's auction all hinge on the blessing of our growing school population. With 92 students this year, we are growing disciples by the dozens and hope to continue that growth. It is our hope in the coming years to expand our school, to gain additional classrooms and additional food storage space.

Ways to support this tithe free event are by donating auction items, monetary donations, purchase of raffle tickets for either of our raffle opportunities or by joining us on October 21st at the Pilot Grove Community Building for a home cooked meal by Haller's Homestyle Catering, and bidding on some great auction items. We ask that auction items be donated by October 19th. Auction items received after October 19th are still welcomed but will not be printed in the final auction booklet, as the books will be printed October 20th. Monetary donations towards this event will be accepted through the end of October by contacting a committee member, dropping off at the office or can be placed in the Sunday collection in an envelope labeled "School Auction".
