Flu Shots

The Cooper County Health Department will be coming to school to give flu shots. If you would like your child to receive a flu shot at school please complete the paperwork that is included in folders this week and return it by Monday, September 30th. Forms cannot be accepted after the date of the 30th, and specifically the day of the clinic. They must be to the health department by Oct 1st so they can get them counted, entered, and be sure to have enough vaccines on hand. They will encourage any who want it, after the 30th, to call and schedule it at the office. For anyone without insurance, or if their insurance doesn't cover the flu vaccine, be sure to mark it on the form, so you can get the the right vaccine at no cost. The tentative date for the clinic at school is Wednesday, October 23rd. Once a date is finalized it will be sent out.
