## What's Happening:

**Science:** We have been working hard getting back into a good science routine. Each student has a notebook designated for their science notes or they can choose to type them on their Chrome Books. These notes will make GREAT study guides come test time!

**Productivity Time:** 7th & 8th grade have a great opportunity on Monday, Thursday, and Friday afternoon for more time to work on anything they need to work on! This is going to be a great time for them to (1) catch up on their AR reading goals, (2) have class time to work on larger projects, (3) rehearse speeches or (4) get done with homework EARLY!
